Receives National Awards**

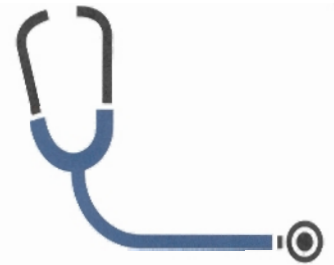
ORLANDO, Fla...Primary Care Access Network (PCAN), a health care collaboration between Orange County Government and area public and private organizations, recently received two awards from the National Association of County Information Officers (NAICO) for its public education projects.

"PCAN is honored to have received such distinguished awards and to be recognized for our hard work in educating the community on the essential need for everyone to have access to a primary care physician," said PCAN Chairman George F. Ellis, M.D.

An award for "Best of Class" was given to PCAN for a video produced by Karin Dorsett Productions. PCAN also received an "Excellent" rating for a brochure describing PCAN's general services to the community that was produced by Pecora & Pecora. Both the video and brochure are used to educate medically uninsured and underinsured residents in Orange County on the primary care health services available to them.
